## Day 1 Prayer Prompt:

For the church:

Pray for the elders as they lead our church. Pray for God's wisdom and direction. Pray for physical and spiritual protection.

For yourself:

Pray for your year at work, that your work would be done with joy and diligence, as if unto the Lord. Pray for opportunities through your daily work to shine God's light and share His good news.



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## Day 2 Prayer Prompt:

For the church:

Pray for the upcoming 13 HRS event for the youth. Pray that God would use this time to grow community among the students and that they will grow closer to Him through it. Pray for energy for the adults and wisdom for Nic as he has the opportunity to disciple teens. Pray for opportunities for them to bring their friends and that the gospel will be seen and heard through this event.

For yourself:

Pray for the kids in your own life, either your own or those around you. Pray for wisdom to love them well and be intentional with conversations and opportunities to disciple their hearts toward Jesus. Pray for spiritual protection over them and that God's truth would be planted in their hearts.



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## Day 3 Prayer Prompt:

For the church:
